David Kellogg is Chief Executive Officer of Solers. Mr. Kellogg founded Solers in 1999 as an employee-owned business, along with six other employees. Mr. Kellogg has led Solers's growth to 140 employees and over \$30 million in revenue for 2005.

Mr. Cauffman is responsible for technical and financial operations, business development, and process improvement for the division, with a staff of over 100 engineers and managers and annual revenue in excess of \$24 million.
